

Reading:

In reading, we will be focusing on the book 'Africa, Amazing Africa'. We will continue to develop our knowledge of reading skills such as retrieval, inference and prediction.

Writing:

We will be using 'Tear Thief' by Carol Ann Duffy to inspire our writing of a newspaper report. We will also be exploring writing poems, diary entries, persuasive posters, and a letter of explanation.

Science:

In Science we will begin learning about Geology. We will be learning about the properties of different rocks and soils. We will be introducing fossils and the process of fossilisation.

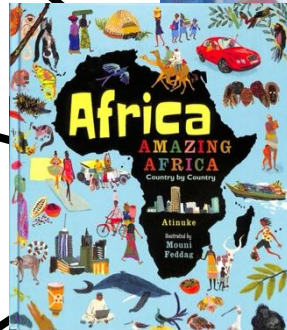
History

This half term, we will be learning about Ancient Greece, we will learn that the civilisation of Ancient Greece gave us many of the things we still use today in the UK.

Geography:

This term, we will learn about the geographical features of Greece and how climate and physical geography influenced human activity in Ancient Greece and continues to today.

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Maths:

This term we will be covering fractions. We will look at converting between mixed numbers and improper fractions.

PHSE:

This half term, we will be exploring the topic, 'Our World/Our Working World'.

Computing:

This half term, we will be looking at emails. We will answer the question: 'What should I do if I receive an email that makes me feel upset and scared?'

Music:

In Music this term, we will be developing singing techniques. We will be learning how to identify minims, crotchets, and quavers.

D+T:

This term, our topic is 'Digital world: Electronic charm'. We will be looking at how we design, code, make and promote an electronic charm.

RE:

This half term, we will be looking into Christianity and Easter. We will be exploring the theme of forgiveness. We will be looking at the big question; "What is good about Good Friday"

MFL:

This term, we will be learning about adjectives in French. We be looking at adjectives to describe colour, size and appearance.
